The Bergen County Division of Community Transportation is applying for funding from NJ Transit, Inc. for a proposed amount of \$1,657,504.00 under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Residents Transportation Assistance Program. The funding will be used to provide transportation service for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. A copy of the application will be available for viewing at the Johnson Public Library in Hackensack within two weeks after the hearing.
